ORGANIC						
<p>Official documents from as early as the mid-1500s attest to the Bertani family heritage in the Valpolicella region. At the start of the last half of the 1800s, brothers Gaetano & Giovanni Battista Bertani set out to establish the first commercial bottler in Valpolicella. They introduced revolutionary vine growing techniques developed by agronomist Jules Guyot, techniques to which Gaetano Bertani had been exposed during his years of political exile in France for his active role in the Italian Unification Movement against the Austrian Empire. Today, Gaetano Bertani, great-grandson of founding brother Gaetano, and his sons, Giovanni and Guglielmo, maintain the family tradition and philosophy. Now in its sixth generation, the Bertani enterprise continues in the tradition of one of the oldest winemaking families in Italy.</p>

CANTINA GORGO - Veneto						
ORGANIC						
<p>Roberto Bricolo started Gorgo back in 1973 with 22 hectares. Today it stretches over 60 hectares, almost all part of the "Bianco di Custoza" and "Bardolino" production areas. He runs the estate with the help of his daughter Roberta. The wines are fresh and direct, with a winning minerality, and have been widely recognized by Gambero Rosso and the rest of the Italian wine press. Gorgo sits on glacial moraine just south east of Lake Garda, near the village of Custoza. The light textured soil of this area is typically whitish, and consists of rock fragments, pebbles, humus and silt rich in calcium carbonate concentration at high pH. The vineyards are managed using traditional local methods including the use of organic fertilizers, and plowing of the vineyards. Harvest, which is almost entirely by hand, can stretch over 45 days to achieve full maturity.</p>

TENUTA CASENUOVE - Tuscany ORGANIC						
<p>Tenuta Casenuove covers some 100 hectares at the heart of Chianti, not far south of Florence, Tuscany. Commercialisation not being the primary concern, the domain has just 28 hectares of vines planted on the best parcels, the rest being left wild. The famous 'galestro', a mix of schist and clay, contributes to the elegance and finesse of the property's production. Of course there is plenty of Sangiovese planted here (10.5 hectares), though merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon are also perfectly adapted to the Tuscan climate. Acquired in 2014 by Philippe Austruy, owner of a cru bourgeois in the Haut-Medoc and a "quinta" in the Douro valley, Tenuta Casenuove was an instant favourite with its subtle wines and immense landscape. The domain produces wine under the Chianti Classico Riserva appellation as well as IGT Tuscany in order to create the blends of their choice.</p>

<p>For centuries Il Palazzo estate has been a stopping point for travelers because of its location along the ancient Via Ariminensis or Salt Road which connected Rome to Rimini. Today it boasts a spectacular agriturismo lovingly restored by the Banelli family in the 1970s along with olive groves and vineyards. This inaugural, export release of the wines, produced from the 105 acre estate just outside of the Classico zone, represent tremendous quality and value. Il Palazzo shares the same winemaker with Tenuta Setti Ponti.</p>

FATTORIA VALACCHI - Tuscany SUSTAINABLE						
<p>Fattoria Valacchi is located in the heart of Chianti, halfway between Florence and Siena in the town of Barberino Val d'Elsa. The property covers 58 hectares, of which twelve are used for vineyards and another twelve for olive trees. Their production focuses on traditional grapes, Sangiovese, Canaiolo, Colorino and Malvasia but important vineyards have been devoted to Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah for their Super Tuscan 'Valicaia'.</p>

TENUTA DI CAPEZZANA - Tuscany ORGANIC						
<p>Historic Tuscan producer whose estate dates to 804 AD. Owned by the Medici family in the 1700s, it was the first demarcated region with its own grape growing rules, establishing the first de facto DOCG in Italy. The 53 km wall separating the Medici's hunting grounds (now known as Carmignano) was called the "Barco Reale". The Capezzana estate was purchased from the Rothschild family in the 1920s by the Bonacossi family who were instrumental in the formation of Carmignano as a formal DOCG. Today Capezzana produces 80% of the entire appellation.</p>

VIGNAMATO - San Paolo di Jesi, Marche ORGANIC						
<p><i>In the late 1940's, Umberto Ceci bought a small plot of land in the San Paolo di Jesi based hamlet of Battinebbia – An area renowned for the quality of its Verdicchio grapes. In the early 1950s, the land was passed down to son to Amato and his wife Maria, keen growers who began selling the family's wines to village locals from the farm building on the estate. In time the winery began to achieve much acclaim across the region, and the third generation of the Ceci family was drawn into the project – Maurizio and his wife Serenella formally established the estate and named it Vignamato, and began exporting to countries outside of Italy. The youngest generation of Ceci's, brothers and sisters Alessandra, Andrea, and Francesco, now run the daily operations here, and they are taking things to even higher levels. Their top white wine "Ambrosia" has been named Tre Bicchieri the past three vintages by Gambero Rosso.</i></p>

D'ANGELO - Basilicata ORGANIC						
<p><i>D'Angelo is a historical family estate in the heart of the major appellation of Italy's deep Southern region of Basilicata. Producing wine on the slopes of mount Vulture, an acidic Volcano (now extinct) since the 1930's and concentrating on the 'Aglianico' varietal, Southern Italy's king of red grapes. The winery concentrates on various single-vineyard expressions of the Aglianico grape and possesses some of the oldest and most important CRU vineyards on the volcano, benefitting from impeccable exposure and high elevation, as well as mineral rich volcanic soils. The secret to D'Angelo's complexity and character is their higher elevation, which allows for heavy diurnal temperature variations whilst maintaining a strong sun typical of Southern Italy. This concentrates aromas and boosts the intensity of the wines, as well as allowing for a strong acidic backbone, whilst allowing for the ripeness to proceed undisturbed.</i></p>

<p>For many years Bruno Fina was the director of the viticultural research institute on Sicily. After working for more than 20 years with one of the most influential enology consultants in Italy, Giacomo Tachis ("Godfather of the Super Tuscans" and collaborator on Tignanello, Sassacaia, and Solaia), Bruno left nothing to chance when researching the best terroir and microclimates in Sicily to plant his vineyards. Sandy and salty soils were selected for the Grillo and Zibibbo vines, Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc and Traminer vines planted on the hills and mountains in the area of Trapani and the Madonie vines were planted with north exposure in order to hide from the hot and strong Sicilian sun.</p>
